## Flight Warning:

Gary McKinnon is a British man who has been charged with hacking into US Pentagon and NASA systems from his home computer in London. Gary does not deny the hacking, but claims he was searching for evidence of a UFO cover-up.

The Home Office is now preparing to extradite him to the United States of America, where he will face a long jail sentence far away from his family if found guilty. Gary has Asperger's Syndrome, and his lawyers argued that because of this and because he could be prosecuted here he shouldn't be extradited. On 31 July 2009, the High Court ruled that Gary's extradition must go ahead. Liberty believes that where conduct leading to a crime occurs in the UK then a British court should have the option to refuse extradition.

In 2006 Parliament passed legislation that would allow a court to do just that – but it has not yet been brought into force. Gary's case shows that we can't wait any longer, urgent change is needed now.

## To fly your message


- Fold in corners, along lines (marked 2)
